Action items:

The featured item on the agenda is decision-making on recommendations by the Multistate Activities Committee. Hence, it's **critical that we have a quorum** on the call. • Jason Hubbart (WVU) is **seeking your assistance**. He asked "how do NERA institution define 'offcampus' rates for F&A?" For instance, the WVU policy reads as "*The off-campus F&A rate (currently* 26%) should be used for projects when the work will be performed in facilities or at sites not owned by WVU and when the project includes sponsor approved rent or usage fees that are directly allocated and charged as a cost of the sponsored project. If a project is located in leased space and the lease is a direct charge to the project, then the project is considered off-campus. Projects requiring off-site field research, data collection, experimentation, survey administration or testing conducted in space or at sites not owned by WVU that do not include project paid rent or usage fees should use the appropriate on-campus F&A rate." Please forward to me (<u>rcr3@uri.edu</u>) your institutional, off-campus rate F&A policy. We'll collate the policies, share with Jason, and post the doc to the NERA website.
