- Sonny Ramaswamy recently sent out a letter to all Deans seeking the identification of institutional liaisons for civil rights and limited English proficiency. The changes reflected in this draft revolve around reducing the number of experiment stations from 15 to 14 (Geneva and Ithaca merge as a single voting station) and minor editorial corrections. Changes to the Rules of Operation require that proposed changes are shared with NERA at least one month prior to voting by the association. Passage of changes requires a 2/3 positive vote.
