## Action items:

- ESCOP continues to have conversations on the topic of "Strategic Realignment." You'll recall that this realignment seeks to aggregate the 40+ lines of the discretionary budget of NIFA to simplify the system's advocacy and make the effort more effective. This is not an exercise to eliminate lines. We're interested to hear your thoughts and concerns on the topic.
- <u>Hotel</u> and <u>meeting</u> registration for the 2019 Joint ESS/NEDA Meeting is open (Nashville, TN, September 23-25, 2019.) The theme for the meeting is **Renewing our Relevancy through Community Resilience**. We'll also do our NERA fall meeting on September 25, 2019.
