1. Request to approve the proposal NE_TEMP2081: Biological Control of Arthropod Pests and Weeds, 10/2013-9/2018 [Renewal of NE1032]

Discussion: Important area and came back with strong reviews. Project has a history of a well-coordinated group with good output. Weak outreach plan. Milestones are vague. Expected outcomes should be measurable and can be better documented. Looks more like a coordinating committee and could better integrate their activities. MAC wants to discuss MRF guidelines and policy issues at the NERA meeting, and wants to send expectations to the Advisors that proposals are clearly integrated and interdependent to be considered a multistate research project.

Action: Recommends conditional approval and proposal to be revised. They need to articulate their milestones, outputs should be measurable (ex. How was release successful?), outcomes should be specific for each objective, and the outreach program need to be strengthened.

2. Request to approve the proposal NE_TEMP2101: Biological Improvement of Chestnut through Technologies that Address Management of the Species, its Pathogens and Pests, 10/2013-9/2018 [Renewal of NE1033]

Discussion: Project has long history of success and had been recognized nationally for its accomplishments. Integration is clearly demonstrated. Appendix E is not yet complete, but majority of current NE1033 participants will continue to participate in the new project. Note that proposal exceeded 15-page limit.

Action: Recommends approval of proposal.

3. Request to approve the proposal NE_TEMP2021: Genetic Bases for Resistance and Immunity to Avian Diseases, 10/2013-9/2018 [Renewal of NE1034]

Discussion: Technical committee had satisfactorily addressed reviewer comments. Solid proposal. Note that proposal exceeded 15-page limit.

Action: Recommends approval of proposal.

4. Request to approve the proposal NE_TEMP2061: Commercial Greenhouse Production: Component and System Development, 10/2013-9/2018 [Renewal of NE1035]

Discussion: Important area for the region, but need to demonstrate and articulate interdependence better. Emphasize Topics 2 & 3, and press for more integrated approach. This is an expensive technology so they need to explain the economic implications to those who will adapt. Consolidate objectives. Reach out to faculty in the urban centers. This is a good project that can have significant impact especially in niche urban markets, and can be easily integrated and multidisciplinary.

Action: Recommends revision of proposal.

5. Request to approve the proposal NE_TEMP2041: Improving Quality and Reducing Losses in Specialty Fruit Crops through Storage Technologies, 10/2013-9/2018 [Renewal of NE1036]

Action: Recommends approval of proposal.

Action: Defer MAC action for discussion at the NERA meeting due to sequestration issues currently on the table.

 NE59: Multistate Research Coordination, Northeastern Region = \$40,788 The funding requested is to support the Northeastern Regional Center for Rural Development.

Action: Recommends approval of NE-59's off-the-top request.

NRSP1 has NIMSS and the Impacts Writing components. Mike Harrington submitted a request to increase the Impacts writing component from \$24K to \$53K, so he can hire the writer fulltime. See request attached.

8. 2013 NERA Planning Grant

MAC held a teleconference on December 10, 2012, and their recommendation to award the 2013 NERA Planning Grant to the following proposals was approved by the NERA Directors by electronic ballot on December 14, 2012:
