- Take a look at the <u>letter</u> that was sent by the BAA (signatories included ESCOP chair, Moses Kairo) outlining "system" recommendations to President-Elect Biden and Vice President-Elect Harris.
- You are probably aware that the NSF has published a RFI on its 2022-2026 Strategic Plan and is inviting feedback on:
 - What are the interests, values and emergent science and policy issues that the Strategic Plan should recognize?
 - How can NSF help maintain US leadership in an evolving global research and education landscape?
 - How can the plan best underscore the importance to the Nation of fundamental research and its broader impacts?

Ali Mitchell and I have spoken and we're interested in providing the NSF with a regional, integrated view on behalf of NEED and NERA. If you have specific thoughts or suggestions on items that should be included in the NSFs new strategic plan, we'd value hearing them. The comment period ends on January 21. We're asking for input by January 14.

Reminders/Updates:

- Last night the President signed both the COVID-19 relief bill and the Omnibus which supports, among others, the USDA. The quick report on the Omnibus: Hatch and McIntire-Stennis were funded at FY2020 levels (\$259 million and \$36 million), while AFRI received a \$10 million increase above FY2020 (FY2021: \$435 million.) For a more exhaustive look at the NIFA's funding, check the Cornerstone Report From Washington.
- In a surprising move, the <u>USDA announced on December 22</u> that President Trump had named Dr. Carrie Castille as the new, six-year term, director of the National Institute of Food and Agriculture. She'll start her new role on Monday, January 4, 2021.
- · Second time: The APLU is hosting a webinar on Agricultural Research Infrastructure Advocacy on

January 11, 2021 at 4:00 PM EST. The webinar will provide an opportunity for directors to learn about materials to support advocacy that advances the \$11.5 billion request for research infrastructure support. Registration is required.
