Caron Gala is leading this, and she is seeking experts to interview on the following topics: (1) the role of capacity funding in supporting a national network of programs of research; (2) research, Extension, and stakeholder partnered innovation in: blueberry production research, wheat/small grain production research, beef/poultry production research, markets and risk forecasting, and watershed/environmental health research, and responsiveness in research and Extension to disasters (e.g., train derailment, Avian Influenza monitoring, COVID testing); (3) how to talk about the federated system of research/development/Extension that is in partnership with the states, counties, or municipalities; and (4) private sector partnerships. If you have suggestions, please send those to us. We are seeking these by the end of the week.
