## Action items:

- · The MAC ballot is now closed and the association approved:
  - NECC2001 Integrating Genomics and Breeding for Improved Aquaculture Production of Molluscan Shellfish (new coordinating committee; 10–approve, 0–reject);
  - Bill Miller NRSP1 AA, Matt Wilson AA NE1544, Mark Hutton AA NE1731, Matt Wilson AA NE1962 (10–approve, 0–reject);
  - Funding for a NERA Planning Grant (Govoni, UCONN; 9-approve, 0-reject.)
- The MAC is still seeking nominations of a regional project for a writing workshop and for national recognition via the multistate research project award. Nominees?
- On October 29, 2019, the USDA issued a <u>press release</u> establishing the U.S. Domestic Hemp Program. An <u>interim rule</u> formalizing the program is available for comment. Areas in which comments are sought include: the archiving of information on the land that hemp is raised, the measurement of THC in the hemp plants, disposal of non-compliant hemp plants, and licensing requirements. While the comments sought primarily fall in the scope of a hemp producer or a hemp industry service provider (e.g., <u>hemp testing laboratories</u>), NERA directors should be aware that guidance is being sought by the USDA.
- Are you experiencing any untoward issues as a result of the NIFA move and workforce reduction? If so, please forward your issues to me, I'll aggregate on the part of the region.

## Reminders/Updates:

You'll recollect that NERA was a signatory on NCFAR's letter supporting S. 2458, America Grows Act, an effort that would authorize a 5% inflation-adjusted increase in the budgets of NIFA, ARS, ERS, and NASS. Two weeks ago, Representative Cheri Bustos (D, IL) submitted an identical bill in the house, H.R. 4174, America Grows Act. NERA is a signatory on NCFAR's letter supporting that companion legislation.
