- While there's no action to be taken, the NIFA relocation story continues to unfold. The GSA has extended the deadline for Kansas City companies to submit bids to host ERS and NIFA. Interestingly, the current landlord of the Waterfront Center, NBL, has filed a complaint that stated "USDA's mini-competition for the delineated area was unprecedented, ill-conceived, and unauthorized by statute and regulation..." Last, until permanent space is identified in Kansas City, the USDA intends to "office" employees in temporary space.
- NERA's goal this year, as part of the Northeast agenda, is to display at least one, high-definition photo on the scrolling banner on the NERA website. We're seeking shots from Rutgers, UConn, UD, UDC, URI, and WVU.
