Convening the electronic meeting will assist in the submission of approved proposals to NIFA in anticipation of an October 1 start date. You'll receive the request to participate via a separate email.
- We're seeking Administrative Advisers for the projects listed below. As a reminder, our NE Guidelines allow for the Director or Associate Director to designate a non-director as an AA, provided that the designee has a level of understanding of and experience with multistate projects. - You'll be voting at the ESS/SAES/ARD Meeting on the renewal of NRSP-1 (*National Information Management and Support System [NIMSS]*). The proposal is posted on the NERA website (http://www.nerasaes.org/nrsp1). Adel Shirmohammadi is the NE AA on the project. An issue has arisen with the proposal. The proposal, at one time, had in the budget, \$13,125 to support, in part, the salary and fringe of the Multistate Impact Statement Director (Sarah Lupis). This was a \$7,125 increase over \$6,000 supported by the current project that expires on September 30, 2017. The increase was removed during a revision to the project. The Western Region recently submitted a request to the NRSP Review Committee requesting restoration of the \$13,125. As a region, the feedback that we've received is that the NE is comfortable with \$13,125 to support the Multistate Impact Statement writing initiative.
- The Experiment Station Section has just released the call for nominations for the Excellence in Leadership Award. You'll recall that Gary Thompson will be presented with as the Northeast's ESS Excellence in Leadership winner this year at APLU. I'd ask that you think about nominees; those are due
